After almost losing hope, a successful surgery restores a patient>s ability to eat Our patient (A.Q./50 years old) went through extremelydifficultdays,allofwhichbecamememories after a precise vascular surgery was performed for him at the Idlib Surgical Specialty Hospital at the beginning of June last year. The patient arrived in a severely emaciated state, indicating clear signs of malnutrition, and reported suffering from a real phobia of consuming any meal or even a glass of water, the price of which would be an immediate call for emergency assistance.

The second patient (A.A.) followed the next day in a state of cardiac and respiratory arrest due to a car accident, and his heart began beating again after cardiopulmonary resuscitation procedures.









