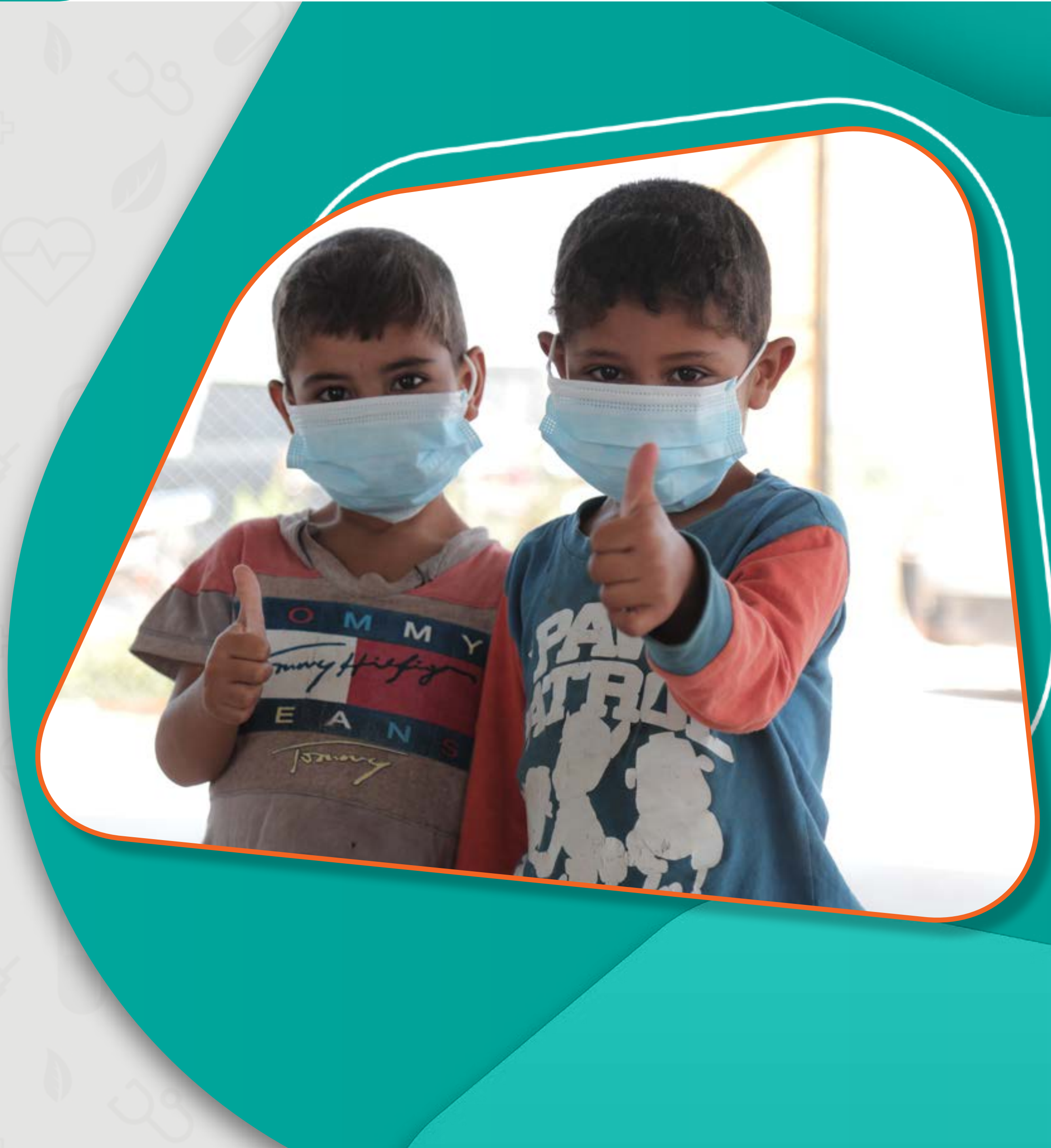

Our patient (A.Q./50 years old) went through extremely difficult days, all of which became memories after a precise vascular surgery was performed for him at the Idlib Surgical Specialty Hospital at the beginning of June last year. The patient arrived in a severely emaciated state, indicating clear signs of malnutrition, and reported suffering from a real phobia of consuming any meal or even a glass of water, the price of which would be an immediate call for emergency assistance.

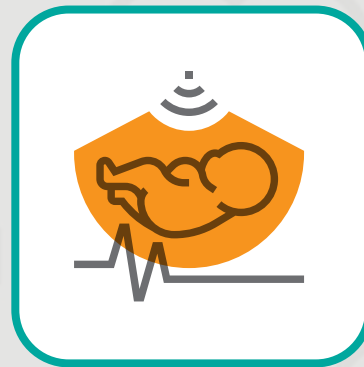
