His recovery story has been inspiring to everyone, encouraging further efforts:






# SEMA responds to a shocking incident: 20 children drown in the Orontes River during a school trip.

The first moments of rescuing a group of children show more than 20 children arriving at Al-Rahma Hospital in Darkoush, including 6 children who passed away, after being pulled from the Orontes River following an accident on the Darkoush road.




