## **256 portions of heating materials were distributed to families in Ariha and Salqin.**

Sema distributed 256 portions of briquette heating materials to 256 families from the northern camps in the areas of Salqin and Ariha.

The distribution targeted the most vulnerable and needy families, providing an average of 80 kilograms of briquette material per family.

This initiative is part of Sema's efforts to provide safe and natural heating materials, especially following numerous incidents of fire caused by burning plastic and cardboard, particularly in the camps.

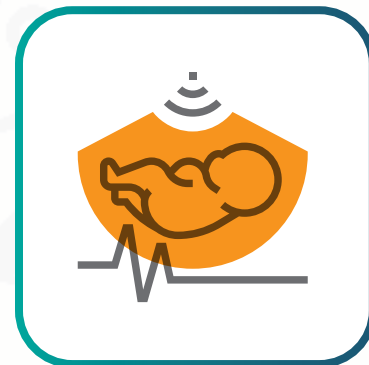
