IRC Delegation Reviews Medical Services at the Specialized Surgical Hospital in Idlib

Today, a delegation from the International Rescue Committee (IRC) visited the Specialized Surgical Hospital in Idlib to review the delivery of medical services and the mechanisms for their implementation. The delegation was received by a number of administrative staff from SEMA Organization and the management of the Specialized Surgical Hospital.

During the visit, Dr. Khaldoun Al-Ameer, Regional Medical Advisor at the IRC office in Amman and the headquarters in New York, expressed his pleasure with the visit, emphasizing the importance of directly observing the reality of work at the hospital. He noted that the team witnessed an advanced level of specialized medical services being provided under extremely challenging circumstances, highlighting that the quality of these services was remarkably distinguished despite the difficulties facing the region as it emerges from the effects of war.

SEMA Activities During the 16 Days Campaign

On the occasion of the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence campaign, which is held annually from November 25 (the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women) to December 10 (Human Rights Day), under the slogan "Safety Everywhere," the Protection Department at SEMA Organization implemented a series of awareness-raising activities at the Ariha and Mahambel centers.

These activities were attended by a group of women and adolescent girls from various age groups. The number of participants reached 30 women and 25 adolescent girls at the Ariha Center, and 20 women and 20 adolescent girls at the Mahambel Center.

This contributes to ensuring quality performance and meeting the needs of donors, funders, and project beneficiaries alike.

On the occasion of International Children's Day, SEMA Organization organized a series of celebratory and awareness-raising activities across its three community centers, reaffirming its commitment to supporting children's rights and enhancing their psychological and social well-being.

The activities took place at the Mahambel Community Center in rural Idlib and the Ariha Community Center, where age-appropriate recreational and educational activities were delivered, bringing joy to children and raising their awareness of their basic rights, with positive engagement from both children and their families.

Additionally, the Amal Center in Bulbul area, rural Aleppo, implemented a community initiative entitled "Peacebuilding," with the participation of children and their caregivers. The initiative focused on promoting social cohesion and peaceful coexistence through interactive activities and constructive dialogue sessions with parents.






