Between Suffocation and Life: The 48-Hour Journey That Saved Little Lujain.

Baby Lujain, only 12 days old, was brought to us suffering from a cyanotic episode and severe coughing. Her tiny body was struggling to breathe, and her labored, interrupted breaths terrified her parents.

She was urgently transferred from the emergency department to the intensive care unit at one of SEMA's hospitals, where her life-saving journey began.

After conducting tests, investigations, and a chest X-ray, it was determined that Lujain was suffering from aspiration pneumonia—a serious condition that affected her small lungs and weakened her ability to breathe.

For a full 48 hours, Lujain remained connected to machines and tubes, fighting silently, while her mother never took her eyes off her.

Burdened by displacement and exhausted by kidney failure, Abdul Aziz finds a new lifeline in Kafr Takharim

Abdulaziz, 52 years old, displaced from the Ma'arat al-Numan countryside to Harem in rural Idlib, is a man worn down by war before illness took its toll on him.

Abdulaziz says: "For six years, after warplanes bombed our area, my blood pressure rose significantly. I already suffered from asthma, but things worsened... and from high blood pressure, I eventually developed kidney failure."

In 2020, after numerous doctor visits, medical tests, and catheterization, he received the hardest news: "There is no life without regular dialysis."

The journey was filled with fear and helplessness, especially under harsh living conditions—without a breadwinner and unable to work—until he was referred to the Kafr Takharim Dialysis Center, supported by SEMA Organization.

Because they are not alone: A humanitarian initiative brings warmth to 19 small hearts and their mothers

At the Specialized Surgical Hospital, the Protection Department carried out a humanitarian initiative to support children suffering from thalassemia. The initiative targeted 19 boys and girls through simple yet meaningful activities aimed at fostering a sense of warmth, safety, and joy despite the harshness of the disease.

The initiative included drawing and clay modeling activities, as well as emotional expression exercises, with mothers participating and dedicated time for dialogue and psychological support. Each child also received a handmade warm woolen shawl, symbolizing care and attention.

The impact of the initiative was clearly reflected in the children through visible signs of joy and relaxation, while providing mothers with moments of calm and reassurance that they are not alone.

Because our children need not only medical treatment, but also joy, warmth, and the feeling of life.





