A Life-Changing Surgery Ends Years of Suffering

A 45-year-old woman had been living for a long time with debilitating symptoms that severely affected her daily life. She experienced rapid heartbeats, recurrent episodes of low blood sugar, extreme fatigue, and persistent hand tremors, leaving her unable to perform simple tasks such as climbing the stairs in her home. As her condition progressively worsened, she sought medical care at Al-Rahma Hospital in Darkoush, hoping to regain her health and return to a normal life.

Following a comprehensive medical assessment and the necessary diagnostic tests, the medical team determined that her condition required a delicate total thyroidectomy.

For the patient, the surgery was far more than a medical procedure—it marked a true turning point in her life, bringing an end to a long period of suffering. Within just a few days after the operation, she began to gradually regain her strength, with a significant improvement in her overall health. During her follow-up visit, she was in stable condition with no postoperative complications and continues to receive regular medical follow-up to monitor her hormone levels and ensure a full recovery.

Ariha Hospital serves as a vital lifeline for thousands of people, providing pediatric and maternal healthcare services, as well as life-saving surgical interventions.





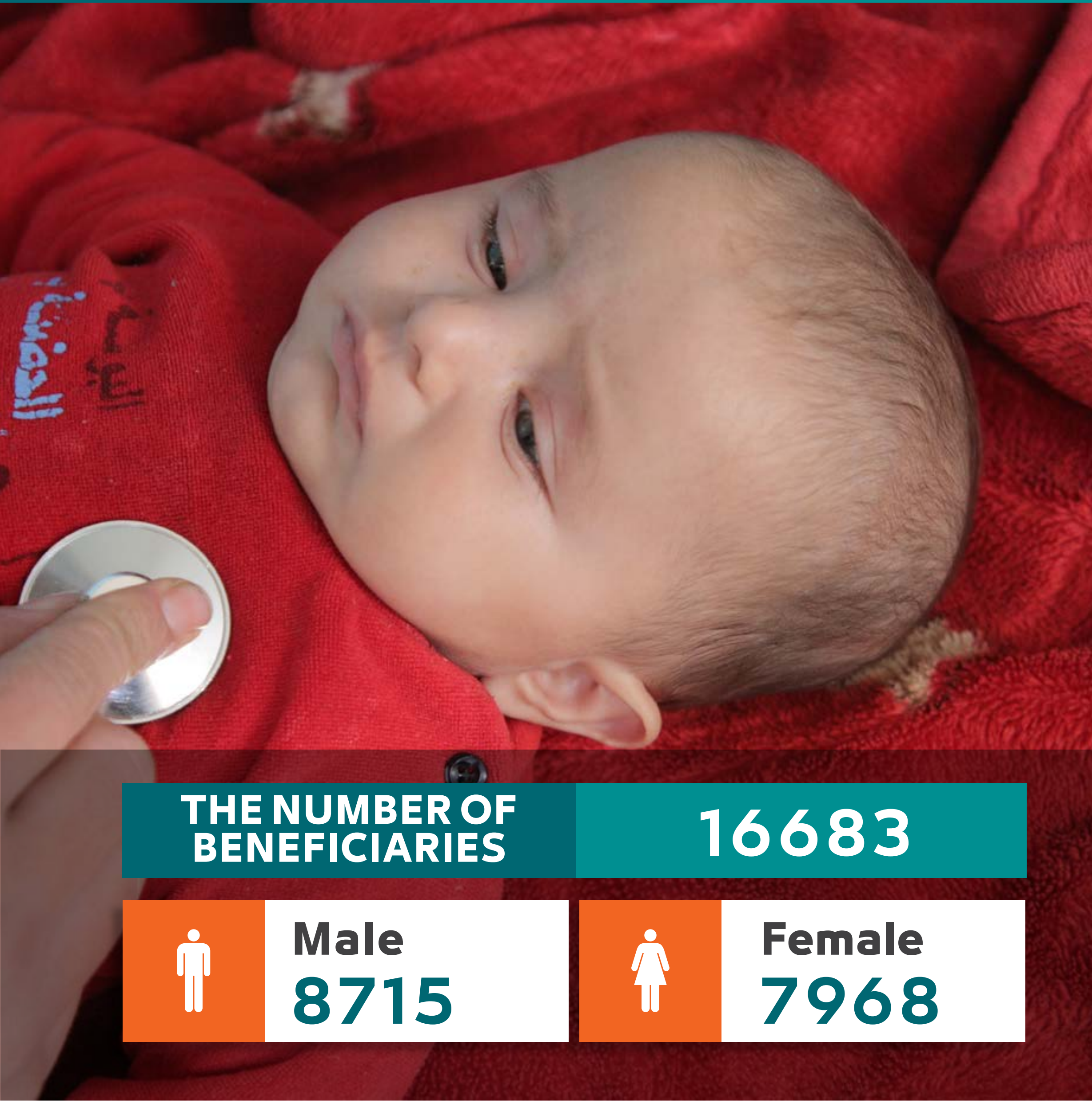
Eid Joy Event to Provide Psychosocial Support for Children with Thalassemia
